

# OUR GINS

## Anno Gin



Appearance: A clear, bright liquid.

Nose: Crisp, complex, and inviting. Juniper and citrus with floral, herbal notes.

Taste: Classic juniper, moving to citrus and then sweet, spiced notes. Overall, soft to start with a complexity of flavours which grows as you sip.

Finish: Bold and long, with leafy herbal notes and hops. Balanced, with a crisp, dry lift at the very end.

Anno Kent Dry Gin is created in Patience, in a fantastic small batch copper pot-still.

## Bathtub



A multi award winning gin made using a traditional method of 'cold-compounding' or 'infusing'. Often considered an inferior type of gin because the flavours are added to a neutral spirit, thereby imitating other 'quality' gins, where either a pot still, or column still are employed, but this has not stopped Bathtub gaining a big following and being awarded numerous medals and trophies around the world in spirit competitions.

Botanicals such as juniper, coriander, cardamom, cassia, orange peel and cloves are infused in top quality copper pot-still spirit, resulting in Bathtub Gin's extraordinary flavour as well as its handsome tint.

Perfect in a classic gin & tonic.

## Bombay Sapphire



Triple distilled; 100% neutral grain spirit is heated into vapour form. Vapour is sent through the rectifying column, unique to a Carterhead still. The baffle system, situated in the column, allows only the purest spirit to pass through.

Purified vapour passes through a copper basket containing 10 natural botanicals and absorbs their delicate flavours. The vapour is turned into liquid and received into a spirit safe as Bombay Sapphire.

The selection and balance of their botanicals is based on a recipe dating from 1761. The selection of botanicals used to create Bombay Sapphire is an extensive process with no expense spared.

Bombay Sapphire is blended with pure water from Lake Vyrnwy and bottled.

## Bombay Bramble



Bombay Bramble gin is a distilled Bombay gin, crafted with 100% natural flavours from freshly harvested blackberries and raspberries.

A new, creative expression of flavoured gin with a bold and rich colour and flavour from a 100% natural fruit infusion with no added sugar



## Bristol Gin Company

Winner of multiple awards including Gold at World Gin Award, Bristol Dry Gin is the product of lengthy development and taste testing and is the first commercially available product from Bristol's micro-distillery at The Rummer.

Beautifully balanced botanicals including Juniper, Citrus, and Angelica root, give this gin a classic dry profile, and loves to be mixed with tonic or vermouth.



## Hendricks

Handcrafted gin with traditional botanicals, juniper, coriander, and citrus peel but the special infusion of cucumber and rose petals creates a unique and unexpected flavour.

## Opihr

Opihr opens your senses to the rich aromas of the ancient spice route.

Discover the exotic intensity of The Orient; Cubebbs from Indonesia, Black Pepper from India & Coriander from Morocco, hand-picked to create a unique oriental spiced gin.

These botanicals then travel thousands of miles along the ancient spice route to their destination, the distillery of G&J Distillers, England's oldest producer of high-quality gin since 1761.



## Sipsmiths

Sipsmith's London Dry Gin is distilled from the finest English Barley spirit with 10 carefully selected botanicals and blended with the exceptionally pure water of Lydwell spring, one of the sources of the River Thames.

Nose: Floral, summer meadow notes, followed by mellow rounded juniper and zesty, citrus freshness.

Palate: Gentle mouthfeel, with initial dry juniper joined by growing sweetness, showing lemon tart & orange marmalade, garnished by a wave of fresh lemon zest, followed by bolder juniper & light dryness, before all the flavours harmonise into one integrated taste.

Finish: Dryness leads, with spicy juniper & a hint of lemon tart emerging.



## Slingsby Rhubarb Gin

A limited edition rhubarb flavoured gin from Yorkshire made with locally sourced botanicals and Harrogate aquifer water. Great with tonic and a slice of pink grapefruit.



## Tanqueray

Clear and pungent, with citrus and juniper aromas.

Very flavoursome with a tart cut, snappy spice, and alcoholic heat on the finish.



## Tanqueray Flor de Sevilla or Royale

Tanqueray Flor de Sevilla is a unique distilled gin made with Sevilla orange essences and other fine botanicals.

Tanqueray Blackcurrant Royale is a sumptuous and unique distilled gin made with French blackcurrants and vanilla notes, elevated with a black orchid inspired flavour, and balanced with the four classic London Dry botanicals

## Our Negroni = Gin, Campari & Carpano Classico

A 19th century bitters created in Milan by Gaspare Campari, made by infusing 68 bitter herbs, plants and fruit in alcohol and water. The result is a rich, complex aperitif which works brilliantly in cocktails such as a Negroni, Americano or a Garibaldi (Campari and fresh orange juice).



"Classico" is quite right for Carpano's Classico Vermouth, the origins of which date back to the late 1700s! Based upon the original recipe created by Antonio Benedetto Carpano, this is a robust, versatile vermouth with plenty of citrus and vanilla.

# OUR RUMS



## Appleton Estate

Crafted to commemorate Appleton's 250th Anniversary, this versatile expression is aged a minimum of 8 years in the tropical climate of Jamaica.

A beautiful expression of Appleton Estate, with aromas of spicy fruit and oak, followed by hints of honey, vanilla, holiday spice and our signature orange peel note.



## Dark Matter

Dark Matter's colour is a deep ruby - mahogany, whilst on the nose has wonderful notes of ginger cake and allspice.

On the palate, it's both powerful and smooth, balancing the tastes of ginger, with a pepper spiciness and flavours of sweet biscuit.

The finish is feisty and energetic.



## Mount Gay

Mount Gay is one of the oldest rum in the world. Since 1703 this rum has been hand-crafted at the same location, using the finest Barbados sugar cane and pure spring water.

Mount Gay Rum's heritage and legendary quality continue to be enjoyed by rum connoisseurs the world over.

Savour the legend of Mount Gay Rum with cola with your favourite mixer or on the rocks.



## Dom Papa

A richly flavoursome rum from the Philippines, inspired by the story of Papa Isio, who played a big part in the late-19th century Philippine revolution.

The rum itself is made using sugar cane grown on the island of Negros in the Philippines and matured in oak barrels for 7 years, after which it is blended and bottled.



## Red Leg

Red Leg is a premium Caribbean rum, blended with spices.

It is distilled in the Caribbean and then brought to the UK for bottling. The secret to the great tasting flavour is down to the blending. The Rum is left to rest in old oak barrels and infused with Jamaican Vanilla and Ginger creating a very smooth tasting rum with a hint of sweet spice.

Nose: An instantly sweet smell of vanilla, followed by warming ginger aroma

Taste: Initial sweetness on the palate, followed by a bite of ginger. Refreshingly, satisfying combination of sweet and spice with a warming mouth feel.



## Wood's Old Navy Rum

Wood's is the only Demerara navy rum still bottled at 57% ABV, the original strength served on British Navy Ships.

Made using traditional pot stills, it is a smooth dark rum with punchy notes of brown sugar and thick toffee.



## Kraken

The Kraken Rum is strong, rich, black & smooth!

It's a great rounded rum & a bit of fun too!

Probably the only spiced rum you can drink neat & also rocks with a splash of coke & a squeeze of lime.

# OUR WHISKYS



## JW Black Label

The colour black has always been associated with style and elegance. The little black dress is always a sophisticated choice whereas the traditional tux can transform any man's appearance.

But black is also intriguing. It has a hint of mystery, of something waiting to be revealed. This is Johnnie Walker Black Label - a deep and complex flavour which is also an unquestionable mark of power and refinement. It is a luxury blend and a luxury brand, with a completely individual personality.

As many as 40 whiskies, each aged 12 years or more, make up this satisfyingly complex blend.



## Highland Park

Located on the Orkney Islands, one of the northern most parts of Scotland, is the Highland Park distillery. Founded on this remote and windswept island in 1798, the distillery has, for more than two centuries produced a full flavoured, single malt Scottish whisky.

Made from the best Barley malted over peat fires; merged with the unique spring waters of the island; and aged in casks for twelve long years that shape its rare and very distinctive character.

Its product retains much that is traditional, even original. It has its own floor maltings and peat beds (the peat is cut shallow to impart a light 'rooty' character) and two traditional peat-fired kilns. During malting a little heather is burned.

The Highland Distillery has more than an affinity with the West Highlands in its flavour than with the palish, fragrant, fresh flavoured North Highland groups of malt.



## Laphroaig 10-year-old

Laphroaig Malt Whisky is distilled in the Islay region of Scotland. Laphroaig (pronounced la-froyg) is one of the most distinctive of all malt whiskies. The distillery was built in the 1820s by Donald and Alex Johnson whose family name is still on the label. In 1847 Donald died in a somewhat bizarre accident after falling into a vat of partially made whisky ('burnt Ale'). For many, it is an acquired taste, but one which rewards persistence. Its palate is smoky with a long aftertaste. If you like Islay smoky whiskies, then you'll love this one, you can almost taste the sea.

# OUR BOURBONS



## Bulleit Bourbon

This is a dark liquid in colour, with a reddish orange tint. Holding classic aromas of rich, toasted oak with hints of vanilla and dried fruits. Providing a smooth and mellow finish of dry spice, caramel, and dried fruit notes.

Bulleit Bourbon 10-Year-Old is Tom Bulleit's selected reserve. Aged in charred American white oak, a select number of Bulleit Bourbon barrels were set aside to age for 10 years to see how the already award-winning bourbon would develop.

Tom Bulleit was thrilled to find the additional years resulted in a special expression of Bulleit that provides a rich, deep, incredibly smooth sipping experience maintaining the inherent character and high rye content for which the brand is best known.



## Maker's Mark

Maker's Mark is the only bourbon distillery to use pure, iron-free limestone spring water exclusively, not city, well or river water. The source is a 10-acre limestone spring-fed lake at the distillery.

The red wax seal you see on the bottle is like a snowflake, no two of them are alike.

They'd be hard pressed to explain what's behind the differences in snowflakes, but it's easy to explain the individuality of our wax patterns.

It's the people who have been hand-dipping the bottles for more than a quarter century. Each one has a different personality that is expressed in the way the wax drips. This is just another step in the Maker's Mark process where people, not machines control the quality of the product.
